A simple, sensible guide to how our North West Employee Engagement Group (NWEEG) community works.

1. Purpose of NWEEG

NWEEG exists to support learning, connection, and community building across the North West.

We are a people-first network — shared knowledge, collaboration, and good conversation are at the heart of every event.

2. Membership Period & Auto-Renewal

- Membership runs on a 12-month rolling basis, January–December.
- We will contact members each autumn to confirm renewal intentions.
- If we do not receive a response by 30 November 2026, your membership will auto-renew for the following year.
- Renewal invoices will be issued automatically unless a cancellation request is received in writing.

3. Event Attendance

- NWEEG events are for registered members unless otherwise stated.
- Spaces may be limited; bookings are confirmed on a first-come, first-served basis.
- If a member cannot attend a booked event, we ask for at least 48 hours' notice so we can allocate the space to someone else.
- Ticket Limits:
 - Core Members: 1 ticket per event
 - Pro Members: up to 4 tickets per event
 - Only book the number of tickets included in your membership tier. If additional tickets are booked, NWEEG reserves the right to either cancel the extra places or invoice for them
